### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

#### Eligibility

- Submissions are accepted, and bursaries are dispersed year-round.
- Submissions must be received on or before the date of travel to the program.
- Applicants may apply once per calendar year.
- Applicants must be Canadian citizens or landed immigrants.
- The age limit for applicants is 35 years at the time of the program.
- Eligible programs can be found at www.artsongfoundation.ca/links/. Requests to submit applications for bursaries to programs other than those listed at the link may be summitted by email before applying.
- Acceptance into the program must be attained before applying for a bursary.
- Only complete applications will be considered.

#### **Budget Information**

- The Foundation provides financial aid for program tuition, transportation in all forms, and accommodation only.
- All figures must be clearly indicated in Canadian dollars on the lines provided on the Bursary Application Form.

#### **Audition Requirements**

- Audition submissions must include (2) video selections of art song performance accompanied by piano. They must be of contrasting style, language, and tempo.
- Audio-only submissions, and opera/oratorio arias will not be considered.
- Videos must be uploaded to a free online platform, such as YouTube or Vimeo. File-sharing services
   (e.g. Google Drive, Drop Box, etc.), and online platforms requiring subscriptions/accounts will not be considered.
- The video identification information on the Bursary Application Form should include clickable hyperlinks to the video URLs; if this is not possible, please make sure the text of video URLs can be copied + pasted (i.e. *do not* write out URLs by hand.)
- Applicants seeking funding to attend programs specializing in the repertoire of a single language must include as
  one of their audition selections a piece in that language. Both selections may be in that language, provided the
  language in question is English, German, or French. If the program specializes in some other language, the applicant
  must provide one selection in the specialty language, and the other in English, German, or French.

#### **Supporting Materials**

- Three (3) documents *must* be submitted in addition to the Bursary Application Form:
  - 1) a copy of an Official Acceptance Letter to the program, in PDF format.
  - 2) a Biography, Résumé, or CV, in PDF format.
  - 3) a Headshot, in any standard format.

#### **Application Process**

- Download and complete the fillable Bursary Application Form.
- Email the completed form to <<u>info@artsongfoundation.ca</u>>.
- *In the same email,* include the three (3) Supporting Materials documents listed above.
- Upload two (2) audition videos, as described above.

All applications will be adjudicated by the ASFC Board, and decisions will be conveyed promptly.
